As **readers and writers** we will know and remember...

- Using nonfiction books to find out about plants and animals.

- information about The Great Fire of London of 1666. Where and when did the fire begin? What happened in the great fire? How did people live in 1666? How do we know what happened?
- How to create paintings, collages, and timelines and take part in activities to learn about the Great Fire.
