Marvellous me



Topic Overview - For the Autumn term our topics have a large focus on Haverigg, Millom and the surrounding areas. The first topic is **Marvellous me**. During this topic we will be learning about ourselves, our family and where we live. In **Geography**, we will be locating our local area on maps and comparing the features to other villages, towns and cities around the UK. The second topic is **Millom Miners**. During this topic we will learn about the Victorian period and how Haverigg and Millom used to be. We will have a large focus on **Millom Mines and the Iron works**.

As **mathematicians** we know and remember:

- Counting numbers to and past 100 forwards and backwards.
- Comparing and ordering numbers from 0 to 100 using the $<$ $>$ and $=$ signs.
- Identifying, representing and estimating numbers using different representations, including the number line.
- Recognising the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (tens, ones).
- Counting in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s.
- Adding and subtracting (one digit and two digit numbers)

As **writers** we will know and remember:

- Writing for a range of different purposes in our Read, Write Inc sessions, including descriptions, letters and short stories.
- Learning how to spell our Year 2 common exception words.
- Orally rehearsing the story *The Papaya that spoke* through the Pie Corbett 'Talk for Writing' approach.
- Editing and planning a new story based on *The Papaya that spoke*.
- **Phonics, reading and grammar and punctuation lessons** will take place in daily Read Write Inc sessions.



As **computer experts** we will know and remember:

- Learning how to turn access the internet independently
- Finding, opening, editing and saving files we are working on.

As **British Citizens** we will know and remember:

- Participating in multifaith week, learning key features of Buddhism.
- Learning the significance of Christmas to Christians.
- Learning the importance of different relationships and how to be a good friend.

As **scientists** we will know and remember:

- Finding out the importance of exercise, eating healthy and keeping clean.
- Naming some of the bones and muscles in my body and saying why they are important.
- Listing ways to help protect my body.

As **geographers** we will know and remember:

- Naming, places and identifying characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom.
- Identifying seasonal and daily weather patterns.
- Studying the human and physical geography of Haverigg and Millom
- Using aerial photographs to recognise landmarks and the human / physical features of Haverigg and Millom.



As **artists** we will know and remember:

- Making different tones using pencils, chalk and charcoal
- Painting things I have seen, remembered or imagined
- Using different techniques like carbon printing, relief, press and fabric printing and rubbings

As **athletes** we will know and remember:

- Running at different paces, using a variety of stride lengths describing the different paces.
- Varying the speed and direction in which I am travelling.
- Travelling at different speeds. Completing an obstacle course.
- Being able to maintain and control a run over different distances.
- Competing against myself and others.
