



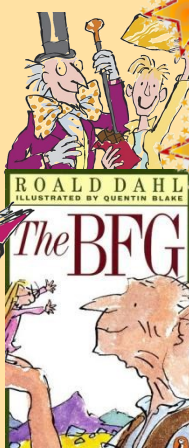

### Attendance Matters



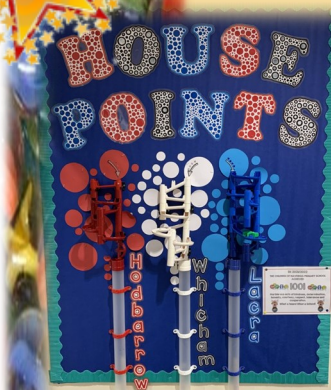

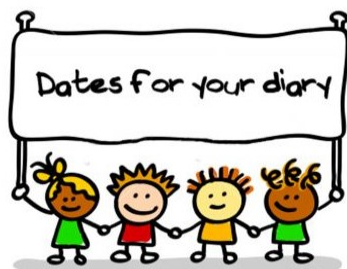
