Attendance Matters



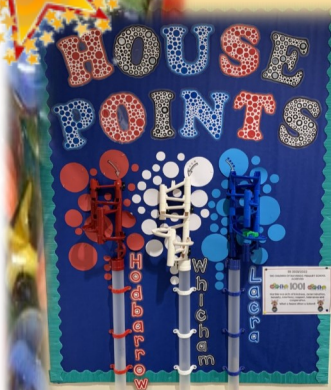

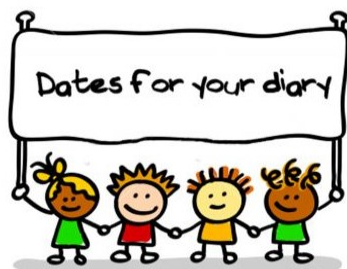

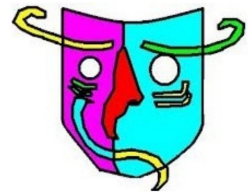
