Letter 3 – Important reminders

Dear Parents / Carers,

This is the third in a series of letters about school reopening in September. This letter is a reminder about uniform and equipment requirements.

What can my child bring into school?

Children will only need to bring in minimal equipment.

<p>Inhalers and any other essential medication: Please can children bring in a spare inhaler and spacer that can be kept in school. These both need to be clearly named. If your child needs any other ongoing medication, please contact school to discuss this.</p>	<p>Show or Tell items: toys, colouring books or objects made at home.</p>
<p>Packed Lunch/Snack: Children won't be allowed to put them in a big rucksack. We have provided each class with an area to store their lunch and snack boxes when they arrive in school. Please make sure they are labelled.</p>	<p>Work completed at home: if your child is particularly proud of a piece of work they have completed send a photo to your child's class teacher via class dojo</p>
<p>Water Bottles: Children in year 2,3,4,5,6 can bring in their own water bottle. We will provide bottles for Reception and year 1. These will be sterilised at the end of each day.</p>	<p>Pencil Cases: all equipment needed will be provided by school.</p>
<p>Sun hats: when the weather is hot.</p>	<p>Sun cream bottles: please ensure you have applied cream before your child comes to school.</p>
<p>Indoor shoes: school will provide bag/individual boxes for them to be stored in for each child. They will stay in school but we will send home when they need replacing.</p>	<p>Big rucksacks: bags/rucksacks can be left at home; children just need to bring lunch boxes. We will provide plenty of space for your child to store their lunch and snack.</p> <p>PE Kits – Your child's teacher will inform you - via class dojo - when your child is going to be taking part in a PE lesson. On this day, your child will wear their PE kit to school with their school jumper or cardigan.</p>

Uniform

From September all children must be in full uniform. This will include:

Uniform Expectations	Extra Information
Uniform	
Grey trousers, shorts, skirts, pinafores Red/white checked summer dresses	We are introducing a new logo and a new colour for our polo shirt. This is a gradually introduction of using the new red polo shirts with a new school logo. There is no expectation to go out and buy new shirts until you need to; these will then need to be red.
Red polo shirt	
Red sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan.	
White or grey school socks	Simple style socks. Avoid big bows and pictures.
Black shoes or plain black trainers	No colours are to be on trainers for school. No additional accessories on shoes for example: Lelli Kellie unicorn bows. Avoid laces for younger children.
Indoor black pumps	These will be left in school.
Hair and nails	Please grow out your holiday hairstyles and any hair dye that has been applied since school closed. Ensure all nail varnish and fake nails are removed.
Earrings	Gold or silver studs only. Please do not send your child into school with hoops, any dangly earrings or decorative studs.
PE Kits	
<p>Summer: Black shorts, red t-shirt and trainers.</p> <p>Winter: Black or dark grey jogging bottoms or leggings.</p> <p>We will be doing a lot of PE outside for safety reasons so please leave a spare set of trainers in school for your child to use.</p>	<p>Your child's teacher will inform you - via class dojo - when your child is going to be taking part in a PE lesson.</p> <p>On this day, your child will wear their PE kit to school with their school jumper or cardigan.</p> <p>Correct PE kit must be worn.</p>
