I can assure you staff are working incredibly hard to make sure learning will be accessible and in line with the curriculum in school. However, I do want to make sure that all our organisation is also in place and as safe as it can be for all. I apologise if this causes you further difficulties but there is a lot to achieve in a very short space of time.
