As **mathematicians** we will know and remember....

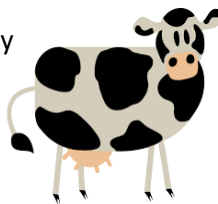
- How to find 1 more and 1 less than a number up to 50.

As **sporty active children** we will know and remember....

- How to increase and develop ball skill, throwing, catching and kicking
- How to develop our skills through team activities and group games

As **musicians** we will know and remember...

- Songs for our Billy Goats Gruff play.
- How to listen and respond to different types of music.
- Musical terms and what they mean including timbre, rhythm and pulse.
