As Geographers we will know and remember:

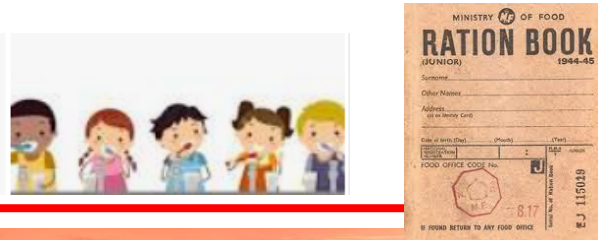
- ~where countries are within Europe, including Russia.

As Scientists we will know and remember:

Teeth and Digestion

- ~ Explain some parts of the digestive system in humans
- ~Explain the different types of teeth in humans and what they do
- ~Describe and explain a variety of food chains, naming producers, predators and prey
- Set up simple practical enquires, comparative and fair tests to investigate the effect different liquids have on our teeth.

Non-Fiction

Information Texts:

- ~ Reading for topic-related information, identifying key words and phrases and taking notes.

Diaries and Letters

- ~ Writing letters and/or diary entries in the role of an evacuee

Narrative

Stories with a historical setting:

- ~ Writing a story set during the Second World War (Developing our skills in punctuation, grammar, spelling and handwriting as we complete all of the above tasks.)

Stories with a twist

- Writing a story with a twist based on Jim and the Beanstalk

Class Novels

- Friend or Foe
- The Chocolate Factory Ghost
- The Christmas Pig

As athletes we will know and remember:

- ~ Inventing, practising and performing a class dance, using music from the 1940's
- How to dribble a football as well as pass and strike.

As Musicians we will know and remember:

- ~ Exploring different musical styles linked to World War 2.
- ~ Comparing musical styles between 1940's - present day.
- ~ Rehearse and perform our class song for the Christmas play.
