

Literacy:

**Labels and Captions**

- **Labelling**
  - Children will learn what labels are and how to use them. They will label body parts and skeletons.
- **Captions**
  - Children will use the knowledge they have from Science to write short captions for photographs of the body.

**Narrative**

- Children will explore the features within a familiar setting using the 'Funny Bones' stories.
- Children will sequence parts of the stories.
- Children will create their own simple familiar setting story using pictures from a Funny Bones book.
- Children will develop sentence structure and use simple punctuation skills (finger spaces, capital letters and full stops).
- Children will learn to include adjectives in their writing to add detail.

**Poems**

- Children will write poems exploring the five senses.



DT & Art:

**Self Portraits**

- Drawing self portraits using a variety of different media. Children will use a range of materials to draw their eyes, mouths and faces.
- Children will explore the work of Picasso and look at how he created his portraits. Children will use a collage technique to create their own portrait.

**Movement and dance**

- Moving around using various parts of the body, responding to music, moving in different ways.

**Games and gymnastics**

- Developing balancing, climbing and throwing and catching skills with use of equipment.
- Team games including relay races.

Geography: Where I live

- **My local area** - using maps to find my school and other local landmarks.
- **Where I live** - looking at what represents our town and also our country.
- Finding out about human and physical features.



Science: **Ourselves**

- **Our bodies on the outside**
  - Children will label body parts
- **Our five senses**
  - Children will explore senses through practical activities
  - Children will understand why these are important in everyday life.
- **Our skeleton**
  - Children will understand what the skeleton is for and how it protects our important organs.
  - Children will begin to understand the job of the heart, the stomach and the lungs.



**Animals**

- We will look at animal skeletons and label animals body parts.

ICT:

- Creating our own stickman animation using 2Animate.
- Word processing - labelling different bones in a skeleton by using a word bank.

RE: The children will learn about Harvest Festivals through practical and creative activities.

Music:

- Singing using 'Sing Up'
- Creating our own version of 'Head, shoulders, knees and toes!'

- **Numbers to 10, 20 and 100**
  - Adding and subtracting
  - Counting in multiples
- **Number bonds and subtraction facts within 20**
- **Understanding and using mathematical symbols**
- **Sequence events in chronological order**
  - Use language relating to dates, including days of the week, months and years.
