SPELLING:

Practise spelling and complete weekly spelling homework as usual. Practise your words for a few minutes most days if you can and remember to bring in your spelling book on Friday.

X-TABLES:

Choose a multiplication table and practise it until you know it very well. Ask someone to test your knowledge of the table, perhaps when you are travelling in the car or walking somewhere. You could even have a race against a relative!

READING:

Read your book at least five times a week. Record each time you have read in your reading journal. Bring your reading record in on a Friday to be checked. This includes reading your book, a newspaper, magazine or a recipe!

HOW WELL DO YOU KNOW YOUR HOME?



You live in the UK but how well do you know the country you live in? Learn 5 new geographical facts about the United Kingdom. It doesn't matter if you focus on Haverigg or Scotland - maybe chose an area you don't know very well?

MAKE YOUR VERY OWN MOON DIARY



Create a moon diary and track the phases of the moon each night. You could sketch some of the different phases and record the names of each phase.

CREATE YOUR OWN ALIEN



Create your very own alien. You could draw a diagram, or use paint or you could create a 3D model. Think about what planet and galaxy your alien is from and how they are different and the same to us Earthlings. They may have special powers - may the force be with you.

FUEL YOUR OWN PASSION TO LEARN



Do some of your own research about a part of space that interests you. Produce a factsheet to show what you have found out. Try to include at least 3 facts and 1 picture on your sheet.

WRITE A POEM IN FRENCH



Challenge yourself to write a poem in French. You can write it on anything you like. You could choose one of the subjects we are learning in class (the weather, emotions, sport).....again, it is up to you!
