Welcome back to school everyone!

I hope you have all benefited from some good rest over the holidays and enjoyed the sunny days. As we start the new school year there are a few important points and reminders to highlight. You may already have done everything on this list, but it's always good to check.

### General points

- ALL school items belonging to your child/children are clearly named – we have an aim to be 'lost property neutral' this year and no longer have the large red trolley.
- Please don't feel pressured to buy new everything – old but still functional lunch boxes are fine as are any items of uniform with old logos on – we have an aim to reduce waste across the board and are also aware of the increased cost of everything.
- Children do not need big back packs in school. Book bags are fine and any bags the children are bringing in should not be any bigger than the Haverigg School backpacks – we are very short of storage space.
- Please check the weather as it is very changeable and ideally children should have some kind of coat/waterproof for playtimes as we will take them out even if it is raining a little.
- In years 2,3,4,5,6 children need a water bottle in school – these will be sent home each day
- After school clubs are due to start next week – more information and details to follow

Teachers will be sending out their class letters and learning overviews this week. If you have any additional questions after looking at these please contact your child's class teacher via dojo.

### Packed lunches

Any children having a home packed lunch need to be thinking 'healthy'. Here are some key points to remember when packing a healthy lunch:

- We are a water only school, so the children will have their water bottles at lunchtime (no flavoured water or additional drinks needed).
- No chocolate bars, chocolate-coated cereal bars, crisps or nuts in packed lunches – our packed lunch policy can be found here:
